Theme 1: Identity and culture			
	R	A	G
I can describe family members and friends			
I can describe relationships using reflexive verbs (me llevo bien, me peleo)			
I can describe what makes a good friend			
I can talk about role models			
I can say what I did, what I normally do and what I am going to do in my free time			
I can talk about music, movies, television programmes, cinema and sports using connectives, modifiers, time phrases, 'suelo'			
I can describe special days, describe birthdays and festivals			

Theme 2: Local area, holiday and travel

I can say what I normally do in the summer using weather phrases ('cuando hace sol,...')			
I can describe a holiday in the past (accommodation, activities) stating what the best thing (lo mejor fue...) and the worst thing was (lo peor fue...)

I can describe a visit to a place in the past

Writing– FOUNDATION

Question 1: Describing a photo (12 marks)				
Describing a photo and give your opinion				
Write 20-30 words in Spanish				
Using simple phrases - do not overcomplicate the sentence				
Describing people, activity, location, mood, weather, clothes– Follow PALMWC				

Question 2: Short writing task (16 marks)				
Responding to 4x bullet points clearly, one paragraph per bullet point				
Writing 40-50 words in Spanish				
Using present tense verbs and opinions successfully				

Question 3: Extended writing task (20 marks)				
Responding to 4x bullet points, one paragraph per bullet point				
Writing 80-90 words in Spanish				
Using opinions and the past, present and future tense successfully				
Using 3TONICS (<i>mi madre dice que es</i> , tenses, opinions, negative, intensifiers, connectives and show-off language)				

Question 4: Translation (12 marks)				
Translating short phrases into Spanish				
Using verbs accurately				
Using the past, present and future tense successfully				
Making sure you have translated all 'little words'				

Writing– HIGHER

Question 1: 80-90 words writing task (20 marks)				
Responding to 4x bullet points, one paragraph per bullet point				
Writing 80-90 words in Spanish				
Using opinions and the past, present and future tense successfully				
Using 3TONICS (<i>mi madre dice que es</i> , tenses, opinions, negative, intensifiers, connectives and show-off language)				

Question 2: Extended writing task (28 marks)				
Responding to 4x bullet points, one paragraph per bullet point				
Writing 130-150 words in Spanish				
Using at least 2 well justified opinions				
Using at least 3 time frames - past, present and future tense successfully				
Adding complexity by using sentence starters and more tenses				

Question 3: Translation (12 marks)				
Translating a short paragraph from English into Spanish				
Using verbs in 3 time frames -check verb endings accurately				
Paying attention to word order e.g. adjectives come after the noun in Spanish				
Using time phrases, opinions and intensifiers accurately				
Checking 'little' words eg. <i>me, mi, su</i>				
Avoiding any English like word				
Don't leave blanks, make educated guesses with unknown words
